Key issues	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2017/18 Accounts & Annual Report agreed - public version to be produced before AGM in September, the Patient & Public Involvement Reference Group (PPIRG) to be involved in that • 360 degree CCG survey had been sent to 79 organisations/bodies - it looks extremely favourable, one of the best nationally • Local Health & Care Plan - Josh Potter presented. It is the Wandsworth version of the South West London Sustainability & Transformation Plan (SWL STP) but with local authority & provider input (local is best, bottom up planning etc). Health & Wellbeing Board are driving it. Priorities identified June/July; written August and engagement in October. I queried engagement but the Board seem lukewarm - engagement fatigue was mentioned. Their thinking seems to be it is the joint working process that is more important than the result. I advised not to miss an opportunity because it's a Wandsworth Plan and locals will appreciate it more than a SWL Plan. • There was a presentation by a St Georges director on how the winter Emergency Care Delivery Board had worked (well in some areas, not so good in others) CCG had a huge input into the work and relationships appear good.
